- IV. Board Reports:
 - A. President: Desiree
 - i. \$1,000 was raised since December from the holiday t-shirt sale fundraiser.
 - ii. Fundraising resources discussed:
 - Krispy Kreme has a nation-wide promotion where you can pre-pay for a dozen donuts (gift card sale) and the organization receives 50% of the sales.
 - Bingo night with designer purses as the prizes (can be slightly used)
 - Read-a-thon
 - Partnering with a plant nursery in Spring and receive a % of sales.
