- IV. Board Reports:
  - A. President: Desiree
    - i. \$18,000 was raised in fundraising since the start of the year.
    - ii. LPC helped with the "Claw out Cancer" initiative and collected \$2,955.62 in total funds. Each family (4 total) will receive around \$741.38 each.
    - iii. Fundraising resources discussed:
      - Mia Bella candles is offering fundraising opportunities. You can place orders for 12-15 days for a 16 oz. candle that costs \$25 and you can make your own label. Your group receives \$8 from each candle.
      - Friendship bracelets cost 8-11 cents on Amazon and it's up to you to set price.
      - LPC Spring Fair tables are available for free to any club/sport that would like to sell something during the fair.
    - iv. Holiday Fair will be held March 9<sup>th</sup> from 10-3:00. We need at least 6 volunteers each day. 2:30-5:30 for Friday set-up and 7-9 a.m. Saturday morning for set-up. Students from NHS may be able to help.
    - v. LPC is holding a Texas Roadhouse fundraiser! Selling dinner rolls and butter for \$10/dozen. We were given a 100-order max and orders can be picked up at Liberty HS. They will be delivered before Easter.

- i. PSBN-In between Spring sports. Purchasing a trailer for equipment for mobile broadcasting. If anyone knows an electrician/HVAC specialist to help with the trailer, please reach out to them. Students are helping run cameras for online broadcasts of the Savannah Bananas in town this week.

  - iii. Track- Season began this week. Voting in Carrie as new Treasurer.

  - vi. Spiritline-Spring yard sales Fundraiser and March will begin the graduation yard sign sales.

  - viii. Administration-Testing season starts next week and every few weeks thereafter. The "Hall of 5's" was updated—when students achieve a 5 on an AP test, their picture is added to the wall. Admn is requesting a red carpet for academic functions and ceremonies. They use one up to 10-15x/year and usually have to rent it each time. Hoping to buy one and would like LPC to help with purchase. \$12 million was granted by the Board to expand Liberty HS and they are in the planning phase of the expansion.
  - ix. Administration-Holding the Athletic Award Ceremony soon which is a semi-formal event. Food is sponsored by Top Shelf. Would like clubs/teams to donate to help with decorations and running the event. They are adding a Liberty HS Hall of Fame. Would like members to help with voting for first ever class to be inducted. 3-community members/3-teachers/6-Coaches. May 17<sup>th</sup> is date of ceremony. Gina Laird also won State Advisor of the Year award.
